Choice Vouchers for BLS

The Statewide Wisconsin Parental Choice Program application period is February 1 – April 20 for the 2023-24 schoolyear. This program is a statewide program that allows eligible families a choice to attend a private school in their area, tuition free. Families are eligible based on an income limit and residency verification. The WPCP voucher is selected through a random drawing of all applications and pays the tuition and registration fees for the year. The application portal is now open and accessible at https://sms.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/

School Immunization Law Changes

Last week, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services announced changes to the WI Administrative Code chapter DHS 144, Immunization of Students for both child care centers and schools. Requirements for school-age children will go into effect at the beginning of the 2023-24 school year.

The following are the updated school vaccine requirements. These are in addition to all requirements previously in place.

- One dose of Tdap is now required for students entering the 7th grade. This was previously required in the 6th grade.
- One dose of Meningococcal ACWY-containing vaccine is now required for students entering the 7th grade and a second dose for students when they enter the 12th grade.
- A parent's report of a student having had varicella (chickenpox) will no longer be an acceptable excuse to avoid the immunization. History of the disease must be documented by a physician, physician assistant, or an advanced practice nurse prescriber by signing the Student Immunization Form.
- Schools will now be required to provide reports of vaccine compliance/noncompliance and outbreaks to both the DHS and the local health department.

Please keep in mind that healthcare providers will see an increase in call volume from parents/guardians trying to schedule vaccinations for their children, or request physician signatures on their child's immunization record. To avoid having your child reported as noncompliant at the start of school next year, please schedule any necessary appointments as soon as possible.





Reduce Your Tuition – Use the RaiseRight Program (formerly Scrip)

RaiseRight (formerly Scrip) is a way to pay for everyday purchases using gift cards in place of cash, checks, and credit cards. Purchase gift cards through Bethlehem's program for various grocery stores, restaurants, department stores or gas stations and earn credit that can be directly applied toward your tuition. You buy the cards at face value and a portion of the discount/rebate Bethlehem receives from the merchant can be applied to your account. It's really that simple! When you use Scrip gift cards at your favorite retailers, you're fundraising -while you shop. There are more than 500 regional and national companies in the program.

Tax Deductions

Tuition payments made before December 31 may be able to be used for the State of WI tuition tax deduction for private school families on your tax return.

The State of WI, allows parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents of private school students in WI could receive an income tax deduction for tuition paid for each kindergarten through high school student. Only the amount paid between January 1 and December 31 will qualify for the deduction and only the amount that you personally paid. We highly recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.

Tuition includes any amount paid by the claimant for a pupil's tuition to attend an eligible institution and mandatory book fees paid to the institution. Tuition does not include amounts paid with a voucher or any amount s paid as a separate charge such as: supplies, rental of equipment, meals, transportation, and personal use items such as uniforms or gym clothes, before or after school child care, extracurricular activities such as music or athletic fees.

Only the person who claims the child as a dependent can use the deduction. For example, grandparents who pay tuition cannot take the deduction (unless or course they claim the child as a dependent).

Ash Wednesday

February 22nd the season of Lent begins as the Church throughout the world observes Ash Wednesday. Lent is a season of repentance and preparation for the celebration of the Holy Week and Easter. One of the customs that comes to us from the ancient church in connection with Ash Wednesday is the imposition of ashes. Ashes serve as a visual sign of the dust-to-dustness of sinful human beings and remind worshipers of the need for cleansing, scrubbing and purifying.

Our worship practice here at Bethlehem has included this ancient ritual as part of our chapel services as well as our regular worship services on Ash Wednesday. Even the youngest of students among us need to be reminded that we are sinners in need of repentance. To that end, we will be imposing ashes again this year. 
