

Next select a student and date, click one of the green squares to schedule that time. Click the "Confirm" button on the "Confirm Meeting" window. To show a list of your scheduled conferences click "Summary." To print out your schedule click "Print." If you feel you need more than the allotted time, please sign up for an additional time slot.

Scheduling will close at 3:00 pm on Tuesday, January 23 and you will no longer be able to schedule online. Conferences schedule after 3:00 on January 24 should be scheduled by contacting the teacher directly.


