Re-Enrollment for the 2024-25 School Years Begins Today / Deadline March 18

Re-enrollment/enrollment for families returning for the 2024-25 school year begins Friday, February 9. To help our planning we ask that re-enrollment take place by Monday, March 18. After March 18 the re-enrollment fee increases and we will open enrollment to new families. We cannot guarantee that seats will be available if you decide to re-enroll later.

Use the link:

https://sycamore.school/family/admissions/register?sch ool_id=2297 or log into your Sycamore account and go to My School / enrollment / Online Portal. At this time, you may also add students from your family who will be new to Bethlehem for the 2023-24 school year.

Remember that re-enrollment is not complete and your child's spot is not guaranteed until all steps are completed AND the enrollment fee has been paid.

Families who were in the WPCP Voucher program for the 2023-24 school year and are applying for WPCP for the 2024-25 school year are not required to pay the enrollment fee but must still complete the online reenrollment by March 18.

School Choice for BLS

The Statewide Wisconsin Parental Choice Program application period is February 1 – April 18 for the 2024-25 school year. This program is a statewide program that allows eligible families a choice to attend a private school in their area, tuition free. Families are eligible based on an income limit and residency verification. The WPCP voucher is selected through a random drawing of all applications and pays the tuition and registration fees for the year. The application portal will be available on February 1st and accessible at https://sms.dpi.wi.gov/ChoiceParent/

Bethlehem is proud to be a participating school in the WPCP, offering families an opportunity for a Christcentered education. Everyone who qualifies is encouraged to apply.

Ash Wednesday

Once again Lent is upon us. Ash Wednesday will be celebrated next week on Wednesday morning. Worshipers have the option of receiving ashes during the service. Both the name "Ash Wednesday" and ancient Christian tradition suggest the imposition of ashes on this day as a reminder of our human frailty and mortality and as a sign of our repentance, sorrow and need for God's grace. The ashes are prepared by burning the palms used last year on Palm Sunday. The ashes are sifted, mixed with just enough olive oil to help the ashes adhere to the skin, and placed in a shallow dish. During the Ash Wednesday rite at the beginning of the service, our students will be invited to come forward and receive ashes either on the forehead or on the hand. This is totally optional for all. A surcharge of \$75 per student is added for returning families who have not completed the re-enrollment and/or made their first tuition payment by August 1st.

Tuition pays for only a small part of the student's education at Bethlehem. The cost to educate a child is about \$9,400 per year. The congregation on average helps cover around 70% of the educational costs. Our tuition rates are very low to help families afford a quality Christian education. When you think of the hourly rate, a family pays about \$3.00 per hour while their child(ren) are in class or about \$20.00 a day for education and care.
