Final Week to Re-Enroll Before Fees Increase

This is the final week for students to re-enroll for the 2024-25 school year before fees increase. We are asking that re-enrollment take place and re-enrollment fees be paid before Monday, March 18. March 18 the re-enrollment fee increases and we will open enrollment to new families. We cannot guarantee that seats will be available if you decide to re-enroll later.
