Online Payments Available

Did you know you can make online payments for tuition, lunch, band, extended care, or other school expenses? You can do this in one of two ways.

Sycamore – Log in and click on MY ACCOUNTING, you will be able to see all your accounts and balances. Click on the green PAYMENT button next to the account that you wish to make a payment on and enter the requested information. Make sure to check the 'I Understand' box and click MAKE PAYMENT. Note: there is a \$2.50 convenience fee added to each payment.

Simply Giving through Vanco – Use this method to set up recurring weekly, monthly or semi-monthly automatic ACH payments from your checking or savings account. Complete the authorization form and submit to the school office. Forms are available through Sycamore by clicking on INFO CENTER/ONLINE FORMS (on the right side of your screen) or ONLINE FORMS (on the left side of your screen). Paper copies of the form can also be picked up in the school office.
