Georgia Ave is Open!

First of all, thank you for being patient with the extended construction on Georgia Ave. We have had very few problems with drop-off and pick-up so far this year. Things are back to normal. Here is the general parking reminder that will be in effect the rest of this school year. We want to thank our neighbors at St. Peter Claver for allowing us to use their parking lot for the past three weeks. That was a big help, especially at the start of a new school year.

There are three main drop-off areas in the morning.

- Georgia Ave the cement apron outside of the main doors
- Alley entrance
- S. 12th Street

Please do not park in those areas, we need to keep the traffic moving. Please find a spot along S. 12th Street, S. 11th Street or Georgia Ave. You need to avoid the bus area (south of the driveway gate) and St. Peter Claver Church parking lot.

If you have a younger student and would like to walk them to one of the doors, please park your car and then walk to one of the entry doors #1 (Main school doors), #5 (back door by playground) or #7 (Century Room).

Dismissal

Students will be leaving from 2 different doors. Please talk with your child(ren) as to where you are going to be parking. You are allowed to park in front of school along Georgia Ave. Crossing guards are used on the alley and at the corner of 12th and Georgia. We ask you to leave the cement apron area open for those who are just driving-by for pick up. Please do not double park when arriving or leaving during the day. You should not be picking up or dropping off from the driving lane in the street. That causes backups into the area streets. Safety needs to be the number one priority. You can also drive through the alley and pick up your student(s) at the gate. Please have your children and yourselves cross the street at the crosswalks. We do not want anyone hit going across the middle of the street.

Reminder – Please do not park or drive through the parking lot next door at St. Peter Claver Catholic Church, come up the alley off S. 11th Street.

Health / Illness

If your child is ill, please do not send them to school. Children who are ill upon arrival at school or become ill during the school day will be sent home. Please pick them up as soon as possible.

If your student is staying home in the morning, please contact the school office as early as possible, and notify us of all symptoms your child has. Voicemails can be left at any time at 920-452-5071 or emails can be sent to infoschool@ourbethlehem.com. Asking a brother or sister to tell the teacher that the child is sick, is not acceptable.

If you are requesting homework, please request it prior to the start of the school day at 8:00 am. The office will communicate your request to the teachers. Requested homework will be available to be picked up between 3:00 and 4:00 pm.
