We will be using the text messaging application through Sycamore to notify you of any delays or closures due to inclement weather. If you have not yet signed up, we highly recommend you do. Log in to your Sycamore account, go to "My School", "My Notifications", select the "Primary Parent" from the drop down menu (we are only able to add one number per family). Make sure the "Enable Messaging" box is checked and then select the correct cell phone number (including area code) in the "SMS". Select your carrier and "School Closing Notifications". Update using the blue "Update" button in the upper right corner.

You may also tune in to these stations for school closing announcements. WHBL 1330AM, WTMJ Channel 4 Milwaukee and WISN Channel 12 Milwaukee. Information will also be posed on Bethlehem's Sycamore homepage, Facebook and Twitter pages. In additional we will email those families that have current email addresses on file with the school.

In the event there is a two-hour delay, there will be no 3K or 4K classes held that day and extended care will not open before classes begin. Tax Deductions

Remember, tuition payments made before December 31 may be able to be used for the State of Wisconsin tuition tax deduction for private school families on your 2020 income tax return.

The State of WI, allows parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents of private school students in Wisconsin could receive an income tax deduction of up to \$4,000 for tuition paid for each kindergarten through eighth grade students and up to \$10,000 per high school student. Only the amount paid between January 1 and December 31, 2020 will qualify for the deduction. We high recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.

Tuition includes any amount paid by the claimant for a pupil's tuition to attend an eligible institution and mandatory book fees paid to the institution. Tuition does not include amounts paid with a voucher or any amounts paid as a separate charge such as: supplies, rental of equipment, meals, transportation, and personal use items such as uniforms or gym clothes, before or after school child care, extracurricular activities such as music or athletic fee.

Only the person who claims the child as a dependent can use the deduction. For example, grandparents who pay tuition can not take the deduction (unless of course they claim the child as a dependent).

Year End Tuition and Extended Care Statements

2020 year end statements can be accessed through your Sycamore account.

Extended Care: "My Accounting", "Summary", "Childcare" - change year in the right side drop down box to 2020, click the "All" tab and click "Yearly Statement"

The Sheboygan County Division of Public Health announced that community testing through the Wisconsin National Guard in the parking lot of the Sheboygan county Aging 7 Disability Resource Center has been extended through March 10, 2021.

Hours are from 10 am until 6 pm at the Sheboygan County Aging and Disability Resource Center parking lot in Sheboygan Falls.

There will be NO testing on Friday, December 25th and Friday, January 1st. Testing is on a first-come, first-served basis, and up to 450 individuals can be tested per day.
