WI National Guard testing will take place every Wednesday and Friday at the <u>Sheboygan County Aging and Disability Resource Enter</u> in Sheboygan Falls.

Testing will not take place on Wednesday, November 11th for Veterans Day, or on November 26th and 27th for the Thanksgiving holiday.

Testing is free for anyone with symptoms or has been in close contact to a positive COVID case, however, the National Guard does not turn anyone away unless they are already at their 300 test capacity for the day.
