Voucher Program

Bethlehem is again participating in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (voucher program), also called WPCP for the 2021-22 school year. Families who qualify for vouchers do not have to pay any tuition, registration fees, or activity fees. Families with students who will be in 4K, 5K or grade 1, and families with students who transfer from a public school in any grade level may qualify.

ALL families who wish to be considered for the 2021-22 school year (including families who had vouchers for the 2020-21 school year), MUST apply online and bring in a residency document before April 15.

Tax Deductions

Remember, tuition payments made before December 31 may be able to be used for the State of Wisconsin tax deduction for private school families on your 2020 income tax return.

The State of WI, allows parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents could receive an income tax deduction of up to \$4,000 for tuition paid for each kindergarten through eighth grade student and up to \$10,000 per high school student. We highly recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.
