### Re-enrollment Deadline is Monday!

Monday, March 8 is the deadline for returning families to re-enroll their students for next year. Families who re-enroll after Monday **OR** who have not paid their enrollment fee by Monday will be charged a \$75 per student late enrollment fee. Also, we will open enrollment to new families beginning Monday and can not guarantee that seats will be available for you if you decide to enroll at a later date.



Remember that to be considered enrolled you must complete the online re-enrollment AND pay the enrollment fee. Until both of these are complete the enrollment process is not finished. **All families are required to re-enroll on Sycamore if you will be attending Bethlehem for the 2021-22 school year (this includes WPCP Voucher families).**

To re-enroll, log into your Sycamore Site and go to My Sycamore / My School / Enrollment / Online Form. You may also use the link <http://app.sycamoreschool.com/enroll.php?schoolid=2297>. Be sure that the re-enroll box is marked and all prefilled information is correct. You will be able to edit, add or delete information as necessary. Near the end you will have the option to print several forms. Print, complete any forms that pertain to your child and turn into the office. You may also add students from your family who will be new to Bethlehem for the 2021-22 school year during this process.

### **Voucher Program / Deadline**

Bethlehem is again participating in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (voucher program), also called WPCP for the 2021-22 school year. Families who qualify for vouchers do not have to pay any tuition, registration fees, or activity fees. Families with students who will be in 4K, 5K or grade 1, and families with students who transfer from a public school in any grade level may qualify as NEW voucher students.



ALL families, including families who already have vouchers, MUST apply online and bring in a residency document before April 15.

### **Tax Deductions**

Remember, tuition payments made before December 31 may be able to be used for the State of Wisconsin tax deduction for private school families on your 2020 income tax return.

The State of WI, allows parents to deduct private school tuition. Parents could receive an income tax deduction of up to \$4,000 for tuition paid for each kindergarten through eighth grade student and up to \$10,000 per high school student. We highly recommend that families work with their tax advisor to determine benefits.
