Final Days to Apply for Free Tuition?

Bethlehem is again participating in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (voucher program), also called WPCP for the 2021-22 school year. Families who qualify for vouchers do not have to pay any tuition, registration fees, or activity fees. Families with students who will be in 4K, 5K or grade 1, and families with students who transfer from a public school in any grade level may qualify.

ALL families who wish to be considered for the 2021-22 school year (including families who had vouchers for the 2020-21 school year), must apply online **AND** bring in a residency document before **April 15. The deadline is FIRM and there is nothing we can do to help if you miss it.**

SALSA Grade School Band Tour

Here are the details for the tour.

1. This is considered an excused absence for band students. Please make sure your child meets with his/her teachers(s) to collect any make-up work.
2. Students should wear dress code-appropriate clothing; there is no "required" wear for the day.
3. Students must wear a mask and remain with their school cohort on the bus and throughout the day.
4. Students will be stopping for lunch in the middle of the day (likely at Culvers). Due to the large number of students, there will be two busses; the busses will split up for lunch to ensure students remain in cohorts and have seating at each restaurant. Please make sure your child has money to purchase lunch for the day.
