2021-22 Enrollment Reminder

If you will be returning to Bethlehem for the 2021-22 school year and have not yet completed your online enrollment, we encourage you to do so. Your student is not considered enrolled and a spot is not guaranteed for them until the enrollment has been completed and the enrollment fee paid. ALL families attending Bethlehem for the 2021-22 school year are required to complete this process. This includes families receiving WPCP school vouchers.

To re-enroll, log into your Sycamore site and go to My Sycamore / My School / Enrollment / Online Form. You may also use the link <http://app.sycamoreschool.com/enroll.php?schoolid=297>. Be sure that the re-enroll box is marked and all prefilled information is current. You will be able to edit, add or delete information as necessary. You may also add students from your family who will be new to Bethlehem for the 2021-22 school year during this process.

Reminder for Students Starting 5K and 6th Grade in Fall

Students entering 5K and 6th grade in fall require additional immunizations. Summer is an excellent time to have your child visit their health care provider for an exam and to receive the needed vaccines. Don't wait until everyone is trying to get in to the physicians in the fall. Please notify the office of any new vaccines so we can update their school records.

Summer Office Hours

Both the school and church office hours will change for the summer months. Beginning Tuesday, June 1 through Wednesday, August 25 the school office will be open Monday – Thursday 7 am – 3 pm and Friday’s 7 am – noon.

Summer Scrip Sales

Scrip on the Go orders will be accepted during the summer months. All special orders need to be in by 8:00 am Monday morning. If requested you will be contacted when your order has been filled and is ready for pick up (you must provide a phone number on your order form if you want to be called). Filled orders can be picked up in the school office Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays 7:30 am – 2:00 pm and Fridays 7:30 am – 11:00 am.

Also, weekend sales will take place after Saturday evening worship service and from 9:00 am – 10:15 am and on Sundays in the church office.

Schedule for Friday, May 28

Our last day of school will take place Friday, May 28. School will begin at the usual time (8:00 am) and we will begin our closing service in the gym at approximately 8:30 am. All students in 3K – grade 8 and parents are welcome to join us for the closing service. We will dismiss after the service at approximately 9:00 am.

There will be Extended Care available before school, but there will be no extended care following dismissal.

Following dismissal, students, parents and families are invited to attend the school picnic at Kiwanis Park until 1:00 pm. Parents are responsible for the transportation to and from the picnic as well as supervision of your children during the picnic. If you will not be attending the picnic, please make sure you have made arrangements for your children. Each student will receive tickets for a sandwich and drink at the picnic and additional food and beverages will be available for purchase. In case of bad weather, we will dismiss after the closing service and there will be no picnic.

Summer Grab-n-Go Meals

School Nutrition will again be offering free breakfast and lunches this summer at select summer school sites. No registration is needed.

Pick up is from 7:30 – 11 am at the following sites: Cooper Elementary, Grant Elementary, Jackson Elementary, James Madison Elementary, Pigeon River Elementary, North High School, South High School and the SASD Central Office at 830 Virginia Avenue.

Pick up dates are June 21 – July 29 (Monday – Thursday). Sites will be closed July 5 – 8. After July 29, the only days for pick up will be August 4 and August 11 at the SASD Central Office locations.

If your child is attending SASD summer school programs, athletics, or other activities, breakfast and lunch will be offered to your child as part of the program.
