COVID Update

In the past weeks Sheboygan County has seen an emergence of COVID-19 cases in our schools. We want to remind parents to keep your child home if he/she has **one or more** of the following symptoms **with or without** a fever.

Cough	Fever	Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
Chills	Muscle pain	Loss or distorted sense of taste or smell
Headache	Sore throat	Congestion/Runny nose
Rash	Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea	Unusual level of fatigue/tiredness

When calling in an absence, please be specific about the reason your child will be staying home and their symptoms (if they are home due to illness).

If your child presents with any (one or more) of the symptoms during the school hours, with or without a fever, your child will be sent home. Please make sure your Emergency Contact Information is current with the office and have a plan or trusted individual to pick up your child in the event your child is sent home from school.

Please teach your child to wash hands frequently, use tissues properly, cover coughs and sneezes with their elbow, and not touch/pick their nose, eyes, or face.

The Sheboygan County Health Department has a very useful site containing weekly updates for Sheboygan County, general information and a list of testing sites as well as their procedures for scheduling testing. MAP Testing

From September 20 – October 1, our students in grades 5K-8 will be taking the MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) Tests. Tests such as these are among the most important tools we have for evaluating individual student academic progress and our curriculum as a whole. These tests can identify strengths and weaknesses and determine which areas, if any, a student may need extra help and in which areas he or she excels. Consider spending a few minutes talking with your child about the purpose and importance of these tests in a way that will ease any anxiety that he or she might have. Encourage your child to do their best, take the test seriously, but now to worry about the results. Each child is a unique gift from God and has value far beyond simple academic evaluations. For each testing day, please ensure that your child gets plenty of sleep, eats a good breakfast, and wears comfortable school appropriate attire.
